– how your carbon footprint is made up.

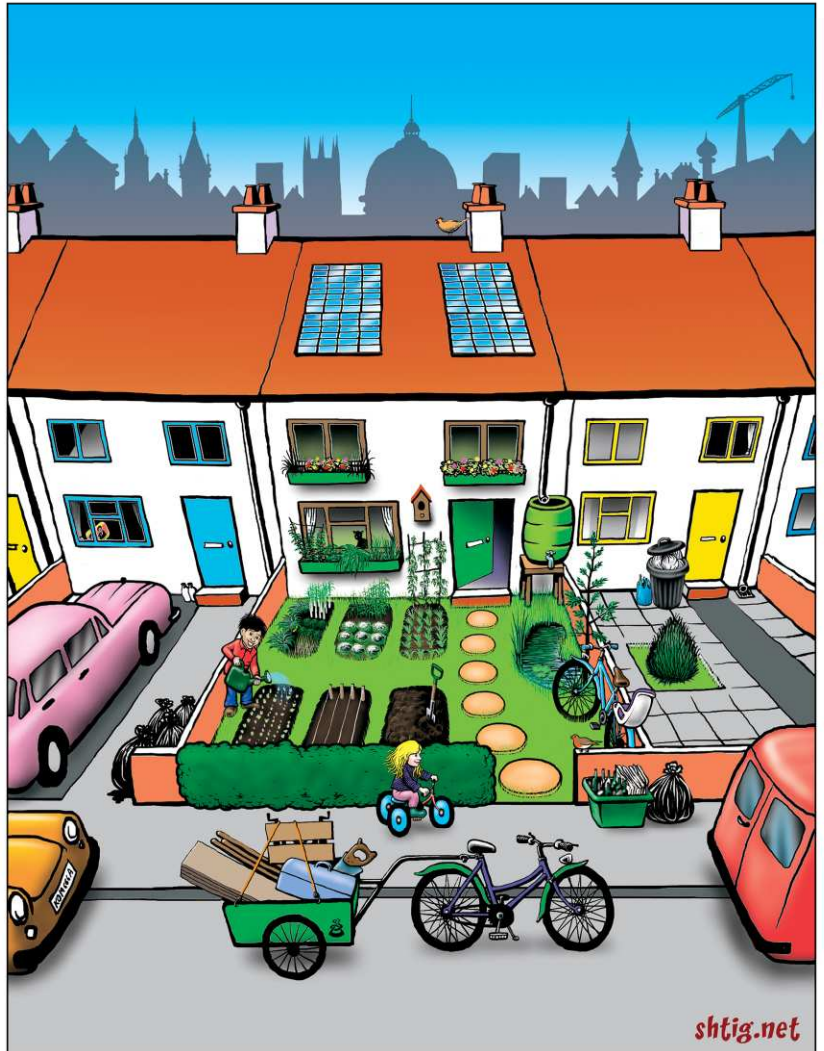
The carbon budget – how carbon emissions vary across the world.

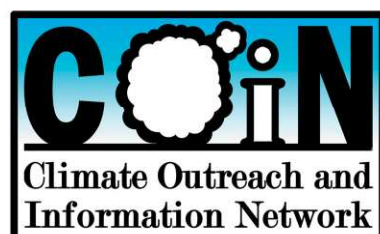
